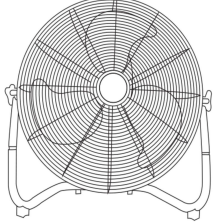

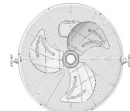

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IMPORTANT SAFETY WARNINGS

- Read rules for safe operation and instructions carefully.
- The product is for household use only.
- Indoor use only.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by manufacturer or its service agent or a suitably qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Connect the appliance to single-phase AC supply of the voltage specified on the rating plate.
- This product must be connected to Earth.
- To protect against the risk of electrical shock, do not immerse the unit, cord or plug in water or other liquid.
- Never insert fingers, pencils, or any other object through the grille when fan is running.
- Disconnect fan when moving from one location to another.
- Be sure fan is on a stable surface when operating to avoid overturning.
- **DO NOT** use fan in window, rain may create electrical hazard.
- **DO NOT** place anything on top of unit.
- **DO NOT** run the cable under carpeting. Do not cover the appliance or the cable. Arrange the cable away from walkways to where it can be tripped over.
- Use the fan in a well-ventilated area. While using, distance of no less than 20cm should be kept away from wall or corner to ensure the air intakes or exhaust openings should not be blocked unexpectedly.
- The fan must not be located immediately below or besides a curtain or the likes.
- Never leave the fan unattended while it is in use. When the appliance is not in use and before cleaning, unplug the appliance from the outlet.
- Extreme caution is necessary when any fan is used by or near children, invalids or elderly person and whenever the fan is left operating and unattended.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision

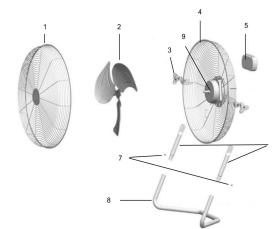
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or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

- Children shall not play with the appliance.
- To avoid the risk of accidental strangulation from the supply cord all children and vulnerable people must be supervised when in the vicinity of the product whether it is working or not.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- **DO NOT** attempt to repair or adjust any electrical or mechanical functions on this unit. Doing so will void your warranty. The inside of the unit contains no user serviceable parts. All servicing should be performed by qualified personnel only.

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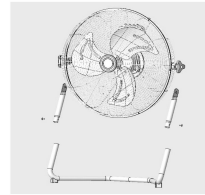
ASSEMBLY AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The fan is packaged with some parts unattached and requiring a little, simple assembly.

WARNING: Do not operate until fully assembled and with all parts correctly attached. The fan blade may have sharp edges. Handle with extreme care.

Assembly

- Unpack the fan and remove all the parts from the package. Retain the packaging until assembly is complete.
- Attach the fan body and the accessory parts from the box.
- Insert the two stand fixing legs into the fan supports by both sides and fix them with the fixing screw provided on the frame.
- Install the main fan body on the fan stand and secure with the mounting screws.
- Adjust the fan tilt angle and tighten the mounting screws in place.



Operating instructions

- Set the fan on a dry, level and sturdy surface.
- Plug the fan in the main.
- The speed is controlled by the speed key box on the rear grille on the fan body.
- To turn the fan On, press down the key either in "I", "II", or "III". To change the speed of the fan by selecting the speed controls keys, i.e. "I" is the low speed, "II" is the medium speed, "III" is the high speed.
- To turn the fan OFF, press down the key "0".
- To adjust the tilt angle of fan, loosen the mounting screws slightly and simply move the fan body unit up or down then tighten them back in position.

Caution: The fan should always be switched off when making this adjustment.

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CARE AND CLEANING

- Disconnect the power and allow the fan rotation to stop.
- Clean the exterior only of this fan with a soft dry cloth.
- Do not use any chemical or abrasive cleaners.
- When the fan is not used for long periods of time, it should be protected from dust and stored in a clean dry place.
- Clean the fan blade and grilles with a soft damp cloth.
- **CAUTION:** The fan blade may have sharp edges. Handle with extreme care.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Use this section to help you to try and solve any problems you may have:

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSES	REMEDIES
The fan is not operating	- The plug is not fully inserted into the wall outlet - The wall outlet experienced an overload - Fuse in plug fails	- Make sure that the plug is fully inserted into the basic AC wall outlet - Unplug the fan, tripped the main electrical breaker box. If you have a tripped breaker, reset it. If the problem persists, contact a qualified, licensed electrician - Remove and inspect the fuse located in the plug. If the fuse is tripped, replace with the appropriate 3 Amp fuse. If the problem persists, contact a qualified, licensed electrician
The fan is rattling	- The grilles are not secured properly - Screws are not securely fastened	- Tighten screws
