2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: May cause sensitisation by skin contact.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: There may be mild irritation at the site of contact.

Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness. The eyes may water profusely.

Ingestion: Large amounts may produce internal irritation, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea and can lead to

drowsiness and unconsciousness.

Inhalation: There may be irritation of the throat with a feeling of tightness in the chest.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

Skin contact: Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water.

Eye contact: Contact lenses should be removed. Irrigate copiously with clean, fresh water for at least 10

minutes, holding the eyelids apart, and seek medical advice.

Ingestion: If accidentally swallowed, wash mouth out with water. Do not induce vomiting, keep at rest

and obtain medical attention.

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Inhalation: Not applicable. There are no appreciable vapours at ambient temperatures.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing media: Carbon dioxide.

Exposure hazards: Non-flammable.

Protection of fire-fighters: Wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin

and eyes.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions: Refer to section 8 of SDS for personal protection details. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and

clothes. Note that spillages constitute a slippage hazard.

Environmental precautions: Do not discharge into drains or rivers.

Clean-up procedures: Clean preferably with a detergent, avoid the use of solvents.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling requirements: Use only in well ventilated areas. Avoid inhalation of vapour. Avoid skin and eye contact.

Smoking, eating and drinking should be prohibited in areas of storage and use. Normal working

practice should be employed.

Storage conditions: Store in cool, well ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed. Keep away from direct

sunlight.

Suitable packaging: Must only be kept in original packaging.
