



Flood Sanitising Wash

A concentrated blend of a Quaternary Ammonium Salt and degreasing agent for use as a sanitising wash when carrying out remedial treatments after flood damage.

Description

Sovereign Flood Sanitising Wash comprises of a concentrated blend of a Quaternary Ammonium Salt, a degreasing agent and other additives in water

This is used to sterilise the building materials after flood damage. Sovereign Flood Sanitising Wash is also a highly active against harmful bacteria such as E-coli, Salmonella and Streptococcus.

Properties

Sovereign Flood Sanitising Wash is integral to dealing with the aftermath of flooddamage. Can be used to sterilise most building materials, such as; brickwork, masonry, stone, plaster, render, etc.

Can also be used externally as a sterilising solution prior to application of protective coatings (e.g. a masonry paint).

Floodwater often contains sewage and associated bacteria that must be treated prior to remediation work.

Note: Where Dry Rot is to be treated, use Sovereign Sovaq FWS.

Usage/Preparation

The 5L Sovereign Flood Sanitising Wash concentrate should be diluted 1 part flood sanitising wash to 4 parts clean water for use. Add the concentrate to the water and stir well.

Application

It is recommended that the areas affected by flood damage be treated prior to removal of plasterwork to prevent contamination of workers during the stripping out process.

Once the plaster has been removed then the underlying masonry should also be treated during the drying out process.

Surfaces should be thoroughly saturated with the solution and badly contaminated areas may require a second treatment; alternatively make the solution stronger by diluting only 2 parts water to 1 part Flood Sanitising Wash

Coverage: Depending upon substrate.

Brush: 5-9 m²/L Spray: 4-6 m²/L
