Instruction Manual

Important Safety Information:



PLEASE read these instructions carefully before installing or using this heater for the first time. The warranty will not cover damage caused by not following these instructions or from misuse.

This infrared heater is designed for safe operation. Nevertheless, installation, maintenance and operation of this appliance can be dangerous if undertaken incorrectly.

Observing the following procedures will reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury. It will also keep installation time to a minimum. Please save these instructions for future reference.

Caution:

Children and vulnerable adults should not, under any circumstances, operate, use, clean or maintain the heater. Some parts of this product can become very hot and cause burns. Children of less than 3 years and other vulnerable people should be kept away from the heater unless continuously supervised.

The unit is at a high temperature during operation. It stays hot for a period after shutdown. Potential injury could occur when touching it during this period.

Assembly and Location:

- 1. Ensure all packaging materials are removed from the heater prior to connection to the Power supply.
- 2. The heater must be positioned at least 1.8 m from the floor, and a minimum distance of 30 cm from the ceiling.
- 3. The electrical supply to the unit should be provided by connecting to a circuit protected by a fuse or miniature circuit breaker suitable for the electrical rating of the unit. Any plug, sockets and switches intended for use outdoors must have a water IP rating as good as, or better than, the protection rating of this Heater.
- 4. The unit should be plugged into a socket which is easily visible and reachable. The heater must not be located immediately above or in front of the socket outlet.
- 5. Never leave this heater unattended when it is switched on

- 6. Do not use this heater with a programmer, timer or any other device that switches the heater on automatically, since a fire risk exists if the heater is covered or positioned incorrectly.
- 7. Do not use this heater in the immediate surroundings of a bath, a shower or a swimming pool.
- 8. Do not place the unit close to any flammable objects. Otherwise there will be a danger of catching fire.
- 9. Do not cover the unit with anything during operation or for a period of time after it's shut down and been allowed to cool.
- 10. Do not wrap the power supply cord on the unit, and always Keep the power cable away from the hot body of the heater.
- 11. Do not use this unit in place where causticity or volatile air exists, i.e. dust, steam, gas, etc.
- 12. Do not use this unit as a clothes drier or towel drier.
- 13. Do not immerse this unit into water for cleaning.
- 14. The unit is at high temperature during operation. It stays hot for a period after being switched off. Potential injury would occur when touching it during this period.
- 15. The unit must be handled with care, it is important to avoid of vibration or Impact damage.
- 16. The unit must be securely grounded during operation.
- 17. When damaged, the unit must be repaired by professional qualified person repairing team.
- 18. If the supply cord or plug is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 19. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- The unit is for household use only. It's not allowed to use on a building site, in greenhouses, barns or stables where there is flammable dust.
- 21. The head of the unit is at high temperature during operation. Unplug the unit and wait till it's cool before cleaning.

WARNING:

This heater is designed for outdoor use only and is not equipped with a device to control room temperature.

Do not use this heater in any confined area or space which is occupied by persons not capable of leaving the on their own, unless constant supervision is provided.

Preparation:

- 22. A cross head screw driver is required.
- 23. Read this instruction manual carefully before installation and use. Keep this instruction manual in a proper and safe place for future use in case needed.

Installation:

- 1. Drill 4 holes positioned as shown above. Insert Plastic Plug (#4), (4 PCs totally) to the holes respectively. Align Wall Bracket (#2) to the holes, and then fix it with Tapping Screw (#3).
- Insert the wall bracket into the hole (Section C) of Control Box. Fix them with the Screw Knob M6*12 (#5).

Operations:

1. Plug in the unit to a socket. Make sure the power supply is same as rated. Press on the switch on the back of the control box. The blue indicator light for the heater start flashing, which means it's in standby status.

- 2. Press button "On" for the heater on the control panel or the remote controller to switch on the heater. Then the blue indicator light for the heater lights up.
- 3. To switch off the heater, press the button "Off" on the control panel of the heater. If pressing the "Off" button on the control panel of the heater, the blue indicator light is off, and the remote control is not functional for the heater. Press "Off" button for the heater on the remote control will only shift the appliance into standby status, and the blue indicator light for the heater start flashing again
- 4. To switch on the LED lighting, press button "On" on the control panel or the remote control for the light. The blue indicator light for LED lighting lights up. When pressing the "Off" button on the control panel or the remote control, the LED lighting is off, and the blue indicator light for LED lighting is off.
