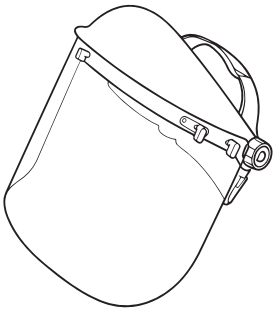

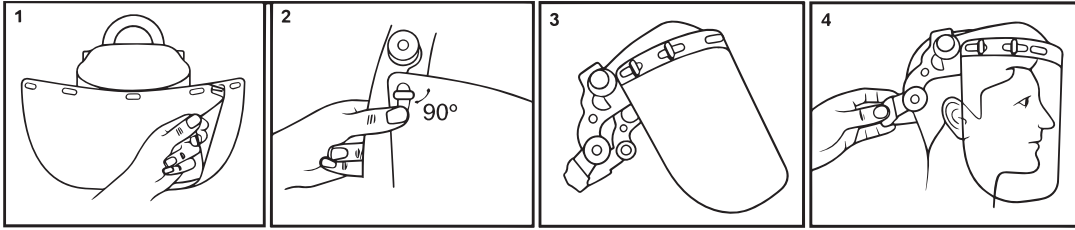

Fitting Instructions

- Peel off the protective film on both sides of the face shield before use. Assemble the clear face shield to the browguard aligning the matching holding pin knobs.
- Turn the 4 holding pin knobs 90 degrees to secure the visor in place.
- Ensure the browguard and face shield are correctly assembled as shown.
- Adjust the back ratchet for safety and comfort. Ensure that the clear face shield covers all the face well.



CAUTION AND WARNING

- The face shield does not provide unlimited protection.
- Check the face shield regularly for noticeable scratching, pitting or any other damage to the lens. Scratching, pitting, or other damage to the lens can seriously reduce the level of impact protection provided by the product, such products should immediately be discarded and replaced.
- No parts on the face shield are replaceable or interchangeable.
- Protectors that have been subject to impact shall not be used and shall be discarded and replaced. If any part of the face shield is deemed unfit for use, then the whole product should be discarded.
- Materials which may come into contact with the wearer's skin could cause allergic reactions to susceptible individuals. the user should check for any such reaction and cease use of the product if any reaction is observed.
- The face shield offers no protection against IR radiation and thus should not be used as primary protection in environments where dangerous levels of IR radiation are present, for example where welding operations are carried out or the casting of molten metal.
- Do not continue using the face shield if the frame is broken or snapped. Do not continue using the shield if the lens is dull, damaged or scratched.
- The face shield should be worn with the proper goggles, spectacles, or mask where the hazard exists.
- The face shield for protection against high-speed particles worn over standard ophthalmic goggles may transmit impacts, thus creating a hazard to the wearer.

Storage

- The product should be kept away from solvents, or solvent vapors or any corrosive materials, as these may seriously reduce the protection provided.
- DO NOT store this product in temperatures over 45°C.

Product life span

Under normal circumstances the product has a useful life of 2 years; where the product is stored and used according to the User Instructions or 5 years from the date of manufacture, whichever comes first.

Cleaning and maintenance

Face shield

To maintain your face shield in good condition:

- Do not use abrasive materials. clean and rinse in warm soapy water and dry with a soft cloth.
- Any part of face-protector which are in contact with the wearer should be disinfected with alcohol.

Suitable accessories and spare parts

This product is not supplied with any accessories or spare parts. If any part is deemed unfit for use, then the whole product should be discarded.

Disposal

The face shield packaging should be disposed of as per local guidance, taking into account recycling of materials if applicable.
