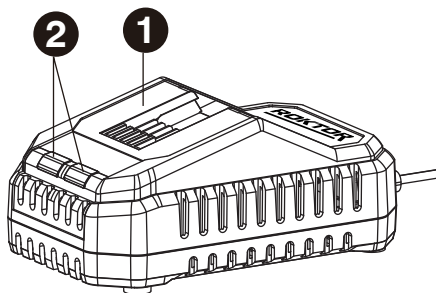
ADDITIONAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR BATTERY CHARGER

1. Before charging, read the instructions.
2. Do not charge a leaking battery.
3. Do not use chargers for work other than those for which they are designed.
4. Before charging, ensure your charger matches the local AC supply.
5. For indoor use, do not expose to rain.
6. The charging device must be protected from moisture.
7. Do not use the charging device outdoors.
8. Do not short out the contacts of battery or charger.
9. Respect the polarity “+/-” when charging.
10. Do not open the unit and keep out of the reach of children.
11. Do not charge the batteries of other manufacturers or ill-suited models.
12. Ensure that the connection between the battery charger and battery is correctly positioned.
13. Keep battery charger's slots free of foreign objects and protect against dirt and humidity. Store in a dry and frost-free place.
14. When charging batteries, ensure that the battery charger is in a well-ventilated area and away from inflammable materials. Batteries can get hot during charging. Do not overcharge any batteries. Ensure that batteries and chargers are not left unsupervised during charging.
15. Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries, as they can overheat and break.
16. Longer life and better performance can be obtained if the battery pack is charged when the air temperature is between 18°C and 24°C. Do not charge the battery pack in air temperatures below 0°C, or above 40°C. This is important as it can prevent serious damage to the battery pack.
17. Charge only battery pack of the same model provided by manufacturer and of models recommended by manufacturer.
18. If the charger emits smoke, unusual odours, excessive heat, or shows signs of damage, disconnect it immediately from the mains supply and discontinue use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



NOTE: Before using the tool, read the instruction manual carefully.

INTENDED USE

This charger is intended solely for charging compatible 18V Li-ion battery packs supplied or approved by the manufacturer.

1. CHARGE THE BATTERY PACK

Do not use any charger other than that specifically provided for use with the equipment. If the battery pack is very hot, you must remove your battery pack from the charger and allow time for the battery to cool down before recharging.

Please charge the battery to reach full before storage. If the tool will not be used for long periods of time, charge the battery every 3 months.

2. TO INSTALL OR REMOVE BATTERY PACK (NOT SUPPLIED) (SEE FIG. 1, 2)

For charging, slide the battery pack back into the battery port. A simple push and light pressure will be sufficient.

Depress the battery pack release button firmly first and then slide the battery pack out from your tool.

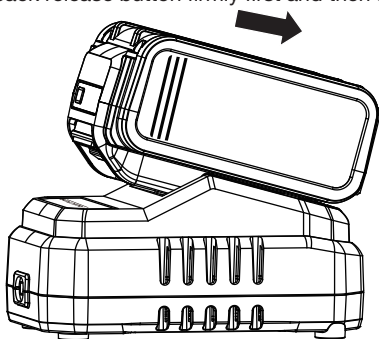

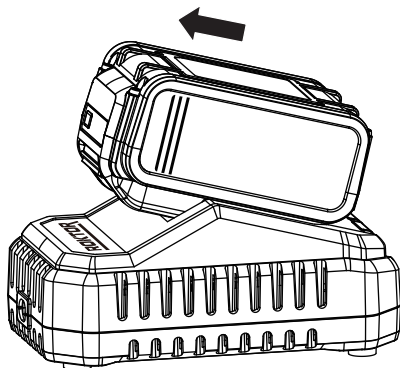

3. WALL-MOUNT HOLES (SEE FIG. 3)

- 1) The charger has hanging holes for convenient storage.
- 2) Install screws in the wall 3 inches (76,2 mm) apart. Ensure the wall and fixings are suitable for the load. Do not mount on plasterboard without appropriate wall anchors. A falling charger may cause injury or damage.

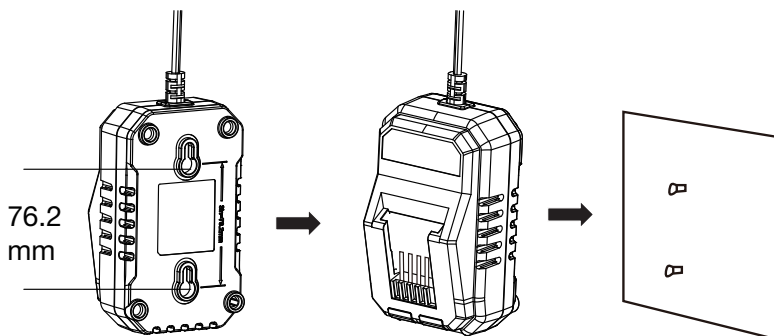

4. CHARGING PROCEDURE (SEE FIG. 4)

- 1) Plug the charger into an appropriate outlet.
- 2) Slide the battery pack into the charger. The light will become green and flash to show charging has started. After fully charged, the green light stays on.

NOTE: If the battery pack is locked in the charger, press the battery pack release button and remove it.

WARNING: When battery charge runs out after continuous use or exposure to direct sunlight or heat, allow time for the tool to cool down before recharging to achieve the full charge. Do not charge the battery on flammable surfaces or near combustible materials.

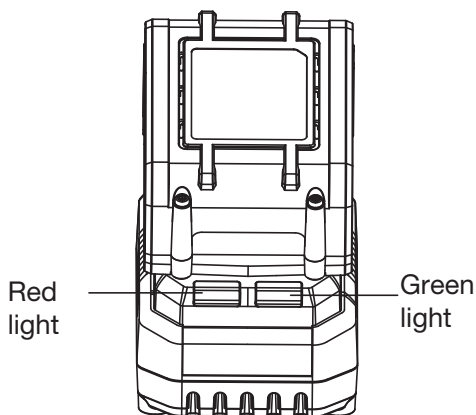

5. CHARGING INDICATOR

This charger is designed to detect some problems that can arise with battery packs. Indicator lights indicate problems (see table below). If this occurs, insert a new battery pack to determine if the charger is OK. If the new battery charges correctly, then the original pack is defective and should be returned to a service centre or recycling service centre. If the new battery pack displays the same problem as the original battery pack, have the charger tested at an authorised service centre.

Light	On/ Flash	Status
Red on 	————	Battery Temperature Protection The temperature of battery pack is less than 0°C or more than 45°C.
Red flash 	- - - - -	Defective Battery
Green on 	————	Fully Charged
Green flash 	- - - - -	Charging

CARE AND CLEANING

MAINTENANCE

Remove the plug from the socket before carrying out any adjustment, servicing or maintenance.

Always disconnect the charger from the mains supply before transporting or cleaning. Your tool requires no additional lubrication or maintenance. Never use water or chemical cleaners to clean your tool. Wipe clean with a dry cloth. Always store your tool in a dry place. If the replacement of the supply cord is necessary, this has to be done by the manufacturer or his agent in order to avoid a safety hazard.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSES	REMEDIES
Battery pack does not charge	• Battery pack is fully charged • Battery temperature is too high or too low • Charger is not properly connected • Charger or battery pack is defective	• Remove the battery pack from the charger • Charge the battery in an ambient temperature • Check and reconnect the charger • Contact customer service centre.
Charger does not power on	• No power at the mains outlet • Charger plug not fully inserted • Power cord or plug damaged	• Check the mains outlet and try another socket • Fully insert the plug into the socket • Replace the charger or power cord
